He was employed as a night bombing Pilot with the 101st Squadron. His airplane crashed on take off on the 5 Nov 1918, just a few days before the war ended. He is buried at Roisel near Peronne France. He is commemorated in Soldier's Tower at the University of Toronto as well as the Strathroy Cenotaph and St Andrews Presbyterian Church.




