After having a wart removed from his tongue in Calgary Military Hospital on the 1st March 1917, Alonzo was sent overseas on the SS Saxonia from Halifax. He arrived in England on the 7th of April 1917. He was Taken on Strength at Etaples France in the 50th Battalion. He was killed in action on the 28th of Sept 1917. He is buried at Villers Station Cemetery, Villers-Au-Bois Pas de Calais France.

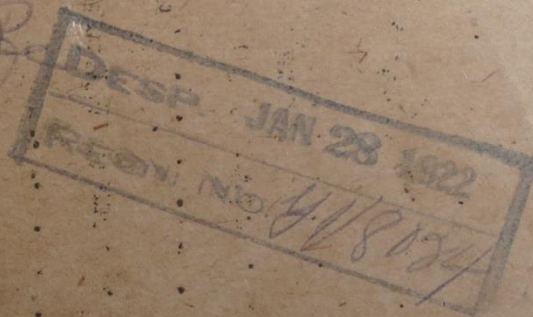
