Cecil Willard Lipsit joined the 113th Btn CEF at Lethbridge Alberta where he had been working as a bank clerk. His parents were Jasper and Charlotte Lipsit of Mount Brydges. He sailed for England on the 26 Sept 1916 aboard the SS Tuscania from Halifax NS. He was drafted to the 43rd Btn, joining them in the field on the 25 Nov 1916. He was killed in action 25 April 1918. He is buried at Aiz-Noulette Communal Cemetery Extension, Pas de Calais France. Lipsit is spelled Lipsitt on the cenotaph.
