On the 9<sup>th</sup> of July 1917 he was awarded the **Military Medal** for bravery in the field. On the 9<sup>th</sup> of November 1917 he was killed in action while serving with the 18<sup>th</sup> Btn. He is memorialized on the Menin Gate Ypres Belgium.
