Summary:

Joseph Harold Payne does not appear in the Commonwealth War Graves Commission records and therefore did not die before August 1921. He is believed to have been a Strathroy born farmer who was drafted the 8th May 1918 in Calgary Alberta. He went overseas to England, but the war ended before he could go to France. He returned to Canada in June 1919 and was discharged at Calgary Alberta on the 25 Jun 1919.
