Joseph Robinson Muldon is another man from Mount Brydges who had gone west to seek his fortune. He attested in the 5th Btn at Valcartier Quebec on the 22 Sept 1914. In June 1916 he suffered a gun shot wound to his thigh. He returned to the 5th Btn after his recuperation but was killed the 9th of April 1917 at Vimy Ridge. He is honoured on the Vimy Memorial.


