

# George M. Faulds Killed in France

Mrs. G. M. Faulds, city, received a telegram from the militia department, Ottawa, stating that her husband, I'te. G. M. Faulds of the 65th battalion had been killed in action in the trenches in France. Pte. Faulds left here with his regiment early in July. As soon as he reached Great Britain he was put on ambulance duty back of the fighting line. Later he was in the great Somme offensive. While in the front line trenches he met his death. He leaves a wife and three small children. They have the sympathy of the entire city and district in their hour of trial. Mrs. Faulds is a sister of Mr. M. A. Hoover, just outside the oty, and Mr. D. L. Hoover, North kattleford.

A memorial service wil be held in his old old place of worship, the Haptist church, on Sunday at the hour of 2.20 h.m. The members of Saskawanna lodge T.O.O.F. of which the deceased was an active and popular member as well as at one time noble grand, will assemble in the lodge hall from where they will, in honor of their departed brother, march to the place of service. Rev. Mr. Becching-will conduct the service at the church.
