

He too was taken on strength with the 15<sup>th</sup> Btn and died in the attack southwest of Thelus France on the 9<sup>th</sup> of April 1917. He is buried near Pte Patterson in Nine Elms Military Cemetery Thelus France. He also appears on the Strathroy Cenotaph and the 15<sup>th</sup> Btn Field Cross
