Frederick J. Lockwood attested in 1st Field Artillery Brigade, 12th Battery at Valcartier Quebec on the 22 Sept 1914, soon after the war began. He had served 13 years with the 47th Regiment at Odessa Ontario. His medical examination was signed by Major John McCrae the future author of "In Flanders Fields". He was killed in action on the 14th of Sept 1916. He is buried at Ovillers Military Cemetery on the Somme in France. (The photo was clipped from a group picture of those taking a Farm course in 1909 in Mt Brydges.

DECLARATION TO BE MADE BY MAN ON ATTESTATION.

I, Frederick Lockwood, do solemnly declare that the above answers made by me to the above questions are true, and that I am willing to fulfil the engagements by me now made, and I hereby engage and agree to serve in the Canadian Over-Seas Expeditionary Force, and to be attached to any arm of the service therein, for the term of one year, or during the war now existing between Great Britain and Germany should that war last longer than one year, and for six months after the termination of that war provided His Majesty should so long require my services, or until legally discharged.
