

Name: Bond, Herbert Clayton

Rank: Pte

Herbert Clayton Bond was the son of James Bond of Mount Brydges Ontario. He sought service in the United States Engineers and landed in France in May 1917. He had worked as a machinist in Detroit. He left a large family of two brothers and five sisters. He was killed on Sept 30th 1918. He is remembered on a grave stone in the Mount Brdyges Cemetery.



Pte. Herbert C. Bond, son of Jas. Bond of Mount Brydges, was killed in action on September 30. He went overseas with the United States Engineers, and landed in France in May. He was 28 years of age. Before enlisting, Pte. Bond was employed as a machinist in Detroit. He is survived by his father, two brothers, William of the Hamilton road, this city, and Burns of Detroit, and five sisters: Mrs. Welch of Hamilton road,
